

2022 U.S. Targhee Sheep Association (USTSA) Starter Flock Program

Purpose?

To promote growth and visibility of the Targhee breed, and to promote youth involvement and education within the breed.

Who is eligible?

Any youth, age 9 to 17 as of January 1, 2022, whose immediate family does not raise Targhee sheep.

What comprises the starter flock?

The winner will be awarded one (1) ewe lamb, one (1) yearling ewe, and one (1) brood ewe donated by members of the USTSA. Each animal will be a USTSA registered animal, and at least QR in scrapie codon 171 genotype.

Promotion?

The program will be featured on the USTSA website, and advertisements will be placed in various trade journals as determined by the USTSA. Promotion by current members at shows and sales is strongly recommended.

Policy and Procedures:

1. A completed application in addition to the supporting materials (listed below) must be submitted (postmarked or emailed) to the USTSA Secretary by April 1, 2022.
 - a. **Essay:** The essay should detail the interest in the Targhee breed, any other sheep or livestock experience, facilities available for raising the sheep and intentions for the sheep.
 - b. **Video/Pictures:** The video or pictures adequately showcase facilities and basic necessities for sheep that will be utilized for raising the awarded sheep.
 - c. **Signed Letters:** There will need to be two signed letters that are required for the application to be considered.
 - i. A signed letter from parent(s) or guardian(s) stating their approval of the application and all the responsibilities (feed, finances, time, etc.) that go along with the possible receipt of the award.

- ii. A signed letter of recommendation from a 4-H/FFA leader, **or** from a current USTSA member.
2. Receipt of application by the USTSA Secretary will be provided to the applicant via email or written letter.
3. Complete applications with supporting material will be reviewed by a USTSA committee, and the top five (5) finalists will be chosen per USTSA policy. Those five (5) finalists will be notified by mail or email of their selection.
4. The 5 finalists will complete an interview with the starter flock finalist committee to determine a winner and an alternate from the 5 applicants. The interview will be conducted via Zoom or some other video conferencing platform that is applicable to the committee members and the applicant.
5. The winning applicant will be notified in writing by June 1st, and will be awarded the starter flock at the 2022 USTSA National Show and Sale, held July 18-20, 2022, in Big Timber, Montana. **Attendance at the National Show & Sale is mandatory.**
 - a. The recipient will be eligible and encouraged to participate in the showmanship competition at the 2022 USTSA National Junior Show. However, participation in the national junior show classes in 2021 will not be permitted.
 - b. The recipient will also be given a \$150.00 buyers credit by the USTSA for use at the 2022 National Show & Sale.
 - c. The other four (4) finalists will be invited and encouraged to attend the 2022 USTSA National Show & Sale.
6. The recipient will be assigned a “mentor” by the USTSA who will be located as close to their residence as possible. The “mentor” will provide knowledge, advice, and support to the winner, and will also occasionally check on the welfare of the awarded animals.
7. Basic necessities (feed, water, shelter, etc) to grow and maintain the sheep in good health must be provided at all times. Failure to maintain the health and welfare of the animals (as determined by the mentor) will result in immediate surrender of the animals to the USTSA at the cost of the recipient.
8. Only a USTSA registered Targhee ram may be used for breeding.
9. The recipient will be required to exhibit at least one of the award animals at a local, county, state or national show by the end of the 2023 calendar year. A brief letter, including a picture, detailing the show must be submitted to the USTSA Secretary by November 1st of either year for publication in *Targhee Talk* and/or posting on the USTSA website.

10. The recipient will also be strongly encouraged to donate animals back to the Starter Flock Program once their flock is established.
11. This is a one-time award – previous recipients may not apply.
